

“Friends” Scrapbooking Class January 26, 2012



Supplies & Instructions

Base:

2 – 12 x 12 Stampin' Up! Very Vanilla cardstock paper to be used as the base of the scrapbook pages.

Borders:

SECRET to using border punches. Take your time. Make sure you line up correctly and complete a full punch on the table. If your paper gets stuck, make sure you carefully remove all pieces of trapped paper.

2 – 2" x 12" Stampin' Up! Designer series paper from the Sale-A-Bration catalog. Trim one side with the Eyelet Border punch. Make sure you line up the paper so that when you finish, the punched edge at the top is a complete scallop. Look at the picture for an example.

2 – 1 ½" x 11" Stampin' Up! Lucky Limeade cardstock. Using the Lace Ribbon Border Punch create a border for the page. Make sure you also line up this punch so that when you finish, the punched edge is a complete scallop. Look at the picture for an example.

2 – 16" Stampin' Up! Calypso Corral Ribbon from the Sale-A-Bration catalog. Lace the ribbon through the Lucky Limeade Lace Ribbon Paper. One of the ribbons will feed through a button and the other end will fold over and affix to the bottom with two sided tape. You can also wrap the ribbon around to the back of the scrapbook page. The second ribbon will also lace through the Lucky Limeade Lace Ribbon Paper but both ends will wrap around the back of the scrapbook page and stick with two sided tape.

2 – 14” Stampin’ Up! Lucky Limeade Ribbon from the Sale-A-Bration catalog. These ribbons will be attached diagonally on each page with two sided tape. The ends should be hidden under picture or embellishments.

Title:

7 – Poppy Parade 1 ¼” circles (punched out with the Stampin’ Up! 1 ¼” circle punch).

Stamp *FRIENDS* onto Very Vanilla cardstock with enough space in between to allow you to use the 1” circle punch to punch out the letters and affix them to the Poppy Parade 1 ¼” circles with foam tape.

Punch out a piece of the Poppy Parade cardstock paper with the Decorative Label Punch. Stamp the Friendship quote onto Very Vanilla Cardstock and punch it out with the Extra Large Oval Punch. Apply the quote to the Poppy Parade Label with foam tape.

Embellishments:

Flowers: Stamp the tri-flowers onto the Very Vanilla card stock. Be sure to orient the stamp on the cardstock so that the punch can be used to easily cut out the flowers. No scissors needed!

Please clean off the stamps before you place them into each ink color.

2 – Pool Party Blue (Use the Pool Party stamp pad)

2 – Poppy Parade Red (Use the fat end of the marker on the stamp)

2 – Lucky Limeade Green (Use the Lucky Limeade stamp pad)

Butterflies: Using the Versamark ink pad and the Vintage Flower stamp, stamp the image four times onto the Poppy Parade cardstock. Twist the image around each time you stamp to obtain good use of the paper and image. Cover the wet inked image with the Stampin’ Up! Cherry Embossing Power, flick into the tray to remove the excess powder. Then dry the image with the embossing gun (looks like a hair dryer). Punch out 6 butterflies. Insert two designer series brads and four regular brads into the middle of your butterflies. Carefully bend up the wings to give the butterflies more volume.

Pictures

Lay out your completed scrap book page pieces onto the Very Vanilla Cardstock.

Lay out how you would like your pictures to look. Using the Label Framelit dies, corner rounder and remaining pieces of cardstock – trim the cardstock to your specifications. Using a mixture of square, rectangle and Label pieces provides a good balance to the pages.

Assembly

Using two sided tape affix the flower border and your green Lace border to your outside page borders. Apply the button with glue dots. Apply your pictures with two sided tape. Apply the butterflies with glue dots. Apply the quote and the Friends letters with two sided tape. Randomly apply the flowers with two sided tape.
