



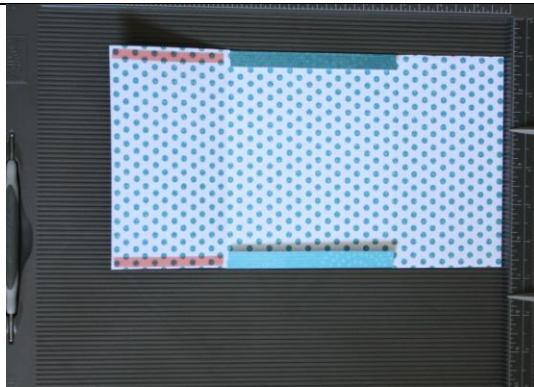


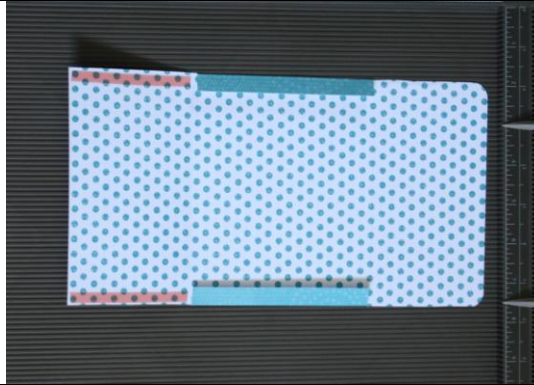
***Angie's Musings with Stampin' Up!***  
***Making an A2 Envelope with the Simply Scored Scoring Tool***

<p>1. Cut Stampin' Up! Designer Series Paper to measure 6 <math>\frac{3}{4}</math>" wide by 10 <math>\frac{3}{4}</math>" long</p>	
<p>2. With the 6 <math>\frac{3}{4}</math>" side at the top, score at <math>\frac{1}{2}</math>" and 6 <math>\frac{1}{4}</math>"</p>	
<p>3. With the 10 <math>\frac{3}{4}</math>" length at the top, score at 3" and 7 <math>\frac{1}{2}</math>"</p>	
<p>4. Using scissors remove four sections from the 3" sections.</p>	

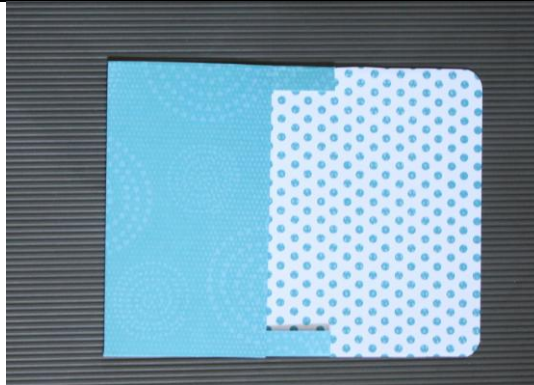
5. Fold in the middle side section and crease with bone folder. Fold the bottom flap up and crease with bone folder. Add sticky tape to the bottom section.



6. Trim the corners of the top panel with a corner rounder.



7. Remove the sticky tape backing and fold up the bottom panel.



8. Insert card and fold down the top flag. I used two sided tape to close my flap.
